- 19. Geosphere portion of the Earth system that includes Earth's interior, rocks and minerals, landforms, and the processes that shape the Earth's surface
- 20. Ecology study of the interactions that take place among the living organisms and the non-living parts of any ecosystem
- 21. Deciduous falling off or shed seasonally
- 22. Coniferous plants that are mostly evergreen trees and shrubs usually having needles or scale leaves
